



Lead tenants are live-in mentors to young people who are part of our Community Adolescent Programs (CAP). This ACT Together program works with young people who are in care and are moving towards independent living, requiring some supports along the way. It's a transitional step – offering young people the opportunity to develop their independent living skills in a safe and supportive environment.

Lead Tenants are volunteers who live with young people as a mentor and role model, assisting them to develop vital life skills, providing day-to-day emotional support as well as monitoring safety and wellbeing.

If you're interested in rent free share accommodation and think you can be a positive role model and mentor for a young person transitioning to independent living, this opportunity as a Lead Tenant will provide you with the chance to make a difference.
